# **Energy Rebate**

Great news for small businesses and households in NSW! The Minns Labor Government is delivering on its promise to provide energy price relief.

Over 300,000 small businesses will soon receive \$650 power bill rebates, a first-time opportunity for them. Eligible small business retail customers won't need to take any action as their relief will be automatically applied by their retailers from July 31, 2023.
